Includes a key for holidays and campus closures.

Class of 2024 YEAR 4. Calendar grid showing weeks from April to May. Focuses on Courses and Electives, including Intercession 2, OSCE, and various blocks (Block 1-12). Includes Intercession 3 and Commencement.
